REGISTRATION GUIDE

Overview

You can register for CAT 2014 from the official CAT 2014 website www.iimcat.ac.in between the period of August 6th, 2014 and September 30th, 2014. Registration steps to CAT 2014 is as follows:

- Register to create a Profile
- Login with system generated User ID and Password
- Submit Application which includes filling details and making an online payment

Upon creating a profile, you will receive a User ID on email and Password on your mobile number. Using these credentials you can log in as Existing User to fill out the Application form. The application need not be completed at once, but you can revisit the form several times. However, once the online payment is made, you will not be allowed to edit any details on the Application form.

Before you Register

Kindly follow the instructions below before you start registration for CAT 2014.

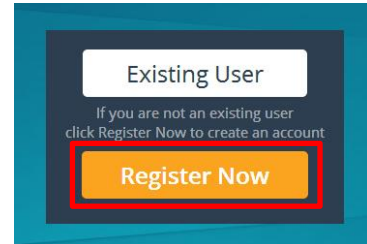
1. Check your eligibility for CAT 2014 by referring to the Eligibility document on the website.
2. Ensure you have a valid and unique email address and mobile number.
3. “*” (asterisk) indicates a mandatory field. The boxes marked with this symbol must be filled in or you will not be allowed submit your application for CAT 2014.
4. Gather all the information you will need, for filling the form, such as:
 - a. Educational history
 - b. Mark sheets (10th/12th/Degree/Diploma)
 - c. Work experience
 - d. Applicable Certificates to upload
 - e. Scanned images of your passport photo and signature
 - f. List of the IIM programmes to which you are applying

Step 1: Registration to get User ID and Password

On the website, www.iimcat.ac.in, click on 'Register Now' for creating your user profile. The Registration Form window will open in your browser.



To fill the Registration Form, kindly use Internet Explorer (Version 7 to 9) or Mozilla (Version 14 to 28) or Google Chrome (Version 20 to 33).

Read the below instructions carefully, before filling the form:

1. Candidate has to fill in the below mentioned details to receive the User Id and Password.
2. Candidate will receive the User Id in the registered email address and Password as SMS on the registered mobile number.
3. Candidate can login with the User Id and Password to complete the application for CAT 2014.
4. Candidate must provide correct Name, Date of Birth, Mobile Number and Email Address as these details cannot be changed once the registration is complete.

The Registration Form to create your User Profile will be as displayed.

The entries on this form cannot be changed once submitted, hence, ensure that you enter the required information correctly.

- **Name of Candidate:** This should be the same as on your 12th/Diploma/Degree certificates.
- **Date of Birth:** Use the calendar icon to select the correct date.
- **Email Address:** Should be valid and unique. You will receive your User ID on this email address only.
- **Mobile Number:** Should be valid and unique. You will receive your Password as an SMS on this number only.
 - India based mobile number should have 10 digits.
 - Other mobile numbers should be prefixed with the area code. Special characters such as (0), +, - are not allowed.

Captcha

The Captcha box (as displayed) is a special set of characters displayed on the screen. You will need to retype the characters in the box provided. This is a safety feature designed to ensure that a human is entering the details and not a computer programme. If you have trouble reading the characters, click on 'Get a new image' to refresh the letters.

To fill the Application Form, kindly use Internet Explorer (Version 7 to 9) or Mozilla (Version 14 to 28) or Google Chrome (Version 20 to 33).

Read the below instructions carefully, before filling the form:

1. Fields marked with * are mandatory.
2. Fill in the important/appropriate details and upload the scanned copy of required documents.
3. Click Save & Continue to proceed to the next section.
4. Use the mouse to move between fields instead of using Tab key.
5. You can do multiple logins to complete your application.
6. Once the payment is made, you will not be allowed to make any changes.

Read the instructions at the start of the form before you begin filling the information. You can *Save* and exit the form any number of times to edit and complete later or *Save & Continue* each section till you submit the application. However, you will not be allowed to continue, if mandatory information is not filled or the required Certificates are not uploaded.

Once you have completed the last section, i.e. Payment, your application to CAT 2014 is considered complete and you will receive a confirmation mail. Post this, changes to any information provided on the application form is not possible. However, you may print or save the form from the website.

- Enter **Father's/Husband's/Guardian's Name** and **Gender** as applicable.

Additionally, download the NC-OBC, SC, ST Certificates from the CAT website, fill, get signatures of appropriate authorities, self-attest and scan as PDF documents to upload.

- Select **Yes** if you are a **Person with disability/Differently Abled**. Additionally, enter details under **PWD/DA Category** of disability, **Disability Percentage** and **Wheelchair Support** requirement.

Note: In order to apply under the PWD/DA category, the Disability Percentage should be equal or greater than 40%.

Download the Differently Abled (Person with Disability) Certificate from the CAT website, fill, and get signatures of appropriate authorities, self-attest and scan as PDF document to upload.

Enter your postal address details correctly as it will be used for communication from CAT Centre 2014. You may also provide an alternate *Email Address* and *Mobile Number* here.

Upload Documents

In this section, you are requested to upload all the mandatory documents as per your selections in the earlier sections.

- **Passport Size Photograph and Signature:** Upload the scanned image of your passport photo with the dimensions 35mm X 45mm. Also, upload the scanned image of your signature with the dimensions 1000mm X 35 mm. The documents file format should be a .jpg or .jpeg and the file size should not be more than 80KB each. The image should be clear with a minimum resolution of 150px.
- **NC-OBC/SC/ST Certificate:** Download the Certificate from the CAT Website, fill, and get signatures of appropriate authorities, self-attest and scan as PDF document to upload here.
- **PWD/DA Certificate:** Download the Certificate from the CAT Website, fill, and get signatures of appropriate authorities, self-attest and scan as PDF document to upload here.

Upload Documents

Note: 1. The NC-OBC/SC/ST/DA/PWD certificate should be in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority.
(Refer to the CAT 2014 website for sample format.)
2. The self-attested scanned copy of the certificate should be clearly visible.
3. Your name on the certificate should match with the name you have mentioned in the Personal Details section.

2. Academics

In this section, you will fill your education details. Enter details for all sections that apply to you. The sections are as follows:

- SSC/10th Std/Equivalent Details
- 12th/Equivalent/Diploma Course Details
- Bachelor Degree Details
- Other Professional Degree Details
- Master Degree Details

For computing percentages of marks obtained in SSC or equivalent and HSC or equivalent examination, the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the mark sheet/grade sheet would be considered. For graduates and postgraduates, the percentage of marks awarded by the Institute/University will be treated as final. If the Institute/University does not award the percentage of marks, it will be calculated on the basis of the marks obtained in all subjects listed in the mark sheet. If any Board/Institute/University awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board/Institute/University specifying the equivalent marks which should be used for filling the online CAT application form. The original equivalence certificate needs to be submitted at the time of interview, if shortlisted for the same.

4. Programmes
